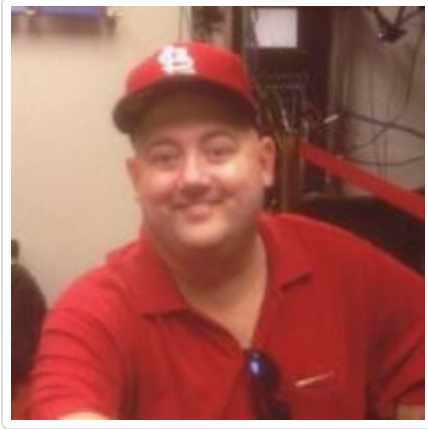




Daniel W. Flayer Jr
