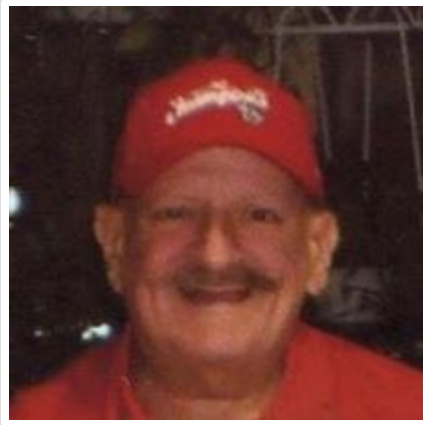




John W. Carleton Jr.
