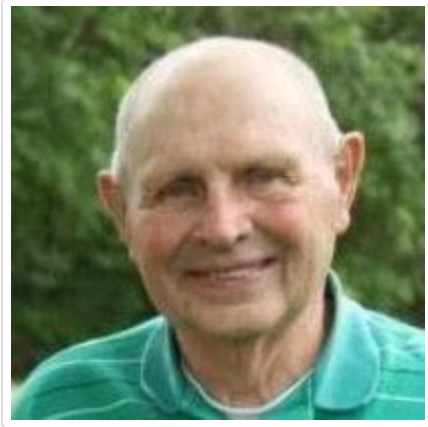




John "Jeep" Frey
