“ I had the pleasure of meeting, and getting to know Michele while I worked in OT at Christian Hospital NE. It turned out Michele and I worked together at 3 of my 4 places of employment.

We were together in a nursing home in west county, and I was hard pressed for assistance in transferring an elderly resident from bed. Ever willing Michele tells me she will help. Michele was wearing a skirt that day, I gave her instruction in how to assist me, we put a gait belt on the lady, said said one, two and three and the lady stands up and proceeds to slide between Michele's knees through her skirt onto the floor behind her! In horror Michele and I lifted the lady back onto the bed where she was safe, and the two of us break out in hysterics that must have continued 5 minutes or longer. We used to re-live this transfer time and time again.

I would frequently co- treat low level patients in ICU or later at a dining table on Rehab with Michele She never ceased to amaze me, Michele would calmly give the patient a one step command and wait 5 minutes for a response from them. I also observed her frequently requesting a patient to make a sound, and have to wait up to 10 minutes for it, while I was trying not to pull my hair out.

We had many lunches and coffee at Einstein bagels when we worked in Creve Coeur, she enabled my new addicted to Twizzlers in west county and I smuggled some Pease's chocolate caramels to her in the last 6 months, much to her chagrin!

I will miss you Michele and our many years of good laughs, and sharing stories.
