And, he wasn't embarrassed to speak to me in the hallway at school (away from wrestling). He was definitely someone I looked up to and someone I wanted to model my actions after as I progressed in wrestling and in life!!

The main memory that has stayed with me over the years is as follows:

I saw Paul in the hallway at school one time and was trying to keep up as he sped up some stairs. As I said I was a freshman and he was a senior, so I was hanging on every word he said as we walked and I lost track of my footing and stumbled up the stairs. Man was I embarrassed at that point and worried what Paul might say. He calmly said something like: "Oh man, I remember doing that when I was your age. My feet grew faster than my body and I stumbled all the time." And we kept walking. It was okay to be awkward and human.
