One thing that I keep hearing from everyone is how she so easily accepted them and loved them. She was your friend. She would give you this big warm hug and kiss. She would listen to you and vent with you. She would cry with you and talk things out for as long as you needed. Even if she didn’t agree with you, she was still your friend and she still loved you.

As her daughter, she taught me strength. She was the strongest person I knew. She had a spine of steel and an iron will. She never backed down from what she believed was the right thing. She taught me that doing the right thing is a very lonely road at times but trust that God will carry you.

The last five years, she battled deep sorrow. We lost my brother, Shane Pace, in October 2010. We all struggled but I just learned recently how badly it haunted her. Some found it easy to judge her during those times. Let me tell you, God doesn’t need help with judging, that is His job not yours. She needed your love, just as she was so willing to love you. She is with Shane now. I believe it was a joyous reunion for her and Shane both. In my mind, he took her fishing as soon as possible. Thank you Shane and mom for the messages you have given me already. While I still cry for you, I’m happy you are both together again.

This has hit Kynan like a brick wall. While he has held strong, I believe he totally lost it at football practice Friday night, the entire practice. His relationship with her was just so sweet.

I can’t tell you how bad this hurts, we all loved her so much. We have two beautiful angels to watch over our family. How I wish we could have spent more time together.

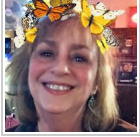

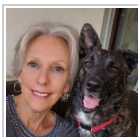
