She married Wilburn L. (Bill) Keller, who also lived in Coulterville, and later they moved to St. Louis where they raised 3 children.

Violet was a dedicated wife and mother until Wilburn's retirement, when they began to travel all over the United States, visiting children and grandchildren in Denver, Birmingham and Mobile, Alabama. They loved to garden and Violet had a very extensive and beautiful daylily garden. She loved to quilt and shared her handiwork generously.
